Daily Readings

Aonday

Read Ephesians 5:1-20. Our messages this week was called "Why Imitate?" and Ephesians 5:1 says to "Follow God's Example." As you read this passage and remember yesterday's worship, what would you say is most central to imitating God's actions?

Tuesday

Read Ephesians 5:1-2. The Bible says that we are "dearly loved children" of our heavenly Father. How do children follow their parents' examples? How does this shape the way you think about following God's example (Ephesians 5:1)?

Wednesday

Read Ephesians 5:3-7. These verses say that immorality, impurity, and greed are signs of idolatry (Ephesians 5:5). How do these and other actions demonstrate what we serve or worship?

Thursday

Read Ephesians 5:8-14. Verse 10 says to "find out what pleases the Lord." How do you find out what pleases someone that you love? How might this apply to serving God?

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Read Ephesians 5:15-20. Verse 15 says that following God's example, living in love and holiness is "wise." Does it seem wise to you? How so?

Saturday

Read John 13:1-17. We know what God is like, more than anything else, because we know what Jesus is like. In this passage, Jesus teaches disciples like us that we should "do as I have done for you (John 13:15)." What would it mean for you to imitate Christ in this example?
