Read Acts 3:1-26. What questions does this passage leave you asking that you want to think about as you reflect on it carefully this week?

Prayer: Open my eyes, O Lord, and teach me by your Spirit.

## Tuesday

Read Acts 3:1-5. Peter and John were going to the temple to pray. Why do you think a regular pattern of prayer is important? Why would it be important to do this together with other believers? On their way to pray, they looked directly at a man who was begging from them, and they asked him to look at them too. Why do you think this looking is so significant? What helps people truly see and be seen by one another?

Prayer: Open my eyes, O Lord, that I may see not only you but the people in my life.

# Wednesday

Read Acts 3:6-8. Peter and John said, "What I have, I give you." This week's message asked us to consider what we have and who we need to give it to you. What has God given you to give to others?

Prayer: Open my eyes, O Lord. Show me your gifts and help me share them with others.

## Thursday

Read Acts 3:9-10. The people who saw this action were amazed at what God had done. Try to think of two or three things that contributed to their amazement. What do Christians do today that has the power to inspire people to praise God?

Prayer: Fill us with your Spirit, Lord, and make us a witness to you.

Read Acts 3:11-16. Peter asked the people why they were so surprised and impressed by this act. Then he told them about the power of Jesus, whom they had rejected. What do Christians do today that draws people's attention to Jesus?

Prayer: Spirit of Jesus, live in us so that others can see you in us.

## Saturday

Read Acts 3:17-26. At the end of this chapter, Peter invites the people around him to turn away from sin (3:26) and turn toward God (3:19). He says to turn "so that your sins may be wiped out and that times of refreshing may come from the Lord." Is there anything that God is calling you to turn away from? How is God calling you to turn toward Him?
